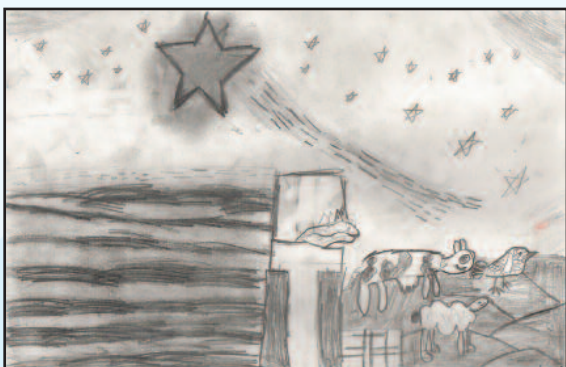

Two pupils from each year group were chosen for their outstanding artwork. The designs were used as the covers for the 'Stable Manners' programmes. Congratulations to all the winners!

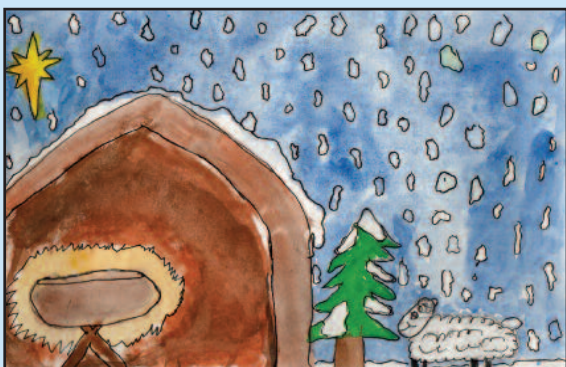
