Dear Parents and Carers,

As the Chair of Governors, I wanted to say another huge thank you on behalf of all the governors and staff, for taking the time to complete the parent/carer questionnaire at the Progress Review week. Nearly half of our families returned the form, and I'm delighted to say that the majority of responses were extremely positive. All the data and feedback is reviewed by the Senior Leadership Team and the governing body, and is extremely useful when planning for the future.

The full breakdown can be seen on the website, but I just wanted to share a few of the results:

- **100%** of you strongly agree or agree that your child *'enjoys school', 'makes good progress', is 'taught well' and 'well looked after'*.
- **100%** would recommend the school to another parent.
- **99%** strongly agree/agree that their child *'feels safe at school', 'the school is well led and managed' and that you 'feel comfortable approaching the school with questions, problems or complaints'*.

There were also lots of lovely comments which have been shared with staff and were hugely appreciated. Any specific comments will be followed up with parents, where appropriate.
